Advanced Search: see ebooks & digital tab at top Can search by grade level, languages, unlim. access, etc. i.e. may be \$10 more for the unlim. access book.... Prior to purchasing, preview the ebook. Look at the info symbol in the preview to see if it can be read out loud, or in book record on catalog.
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How do I run usage reports for ebooks?	Follett Shelf reports for use, setting checkout period, etc. are in the same format as Destiny pages. They will be very familiar to you. Usage reports lets you see what is checked out, when, by whom.
How do I “weed” the collection?	You can hide books.

How do I keep my 1st graders from checking out an ebook written an older student?

Right now, there is no way to differentiate the books for different grade levels. But...
In the works: you can set books to be visible only for students above a certain grade level or only visible to students who graduate after a certain year.
