## The Importance of Collaboration

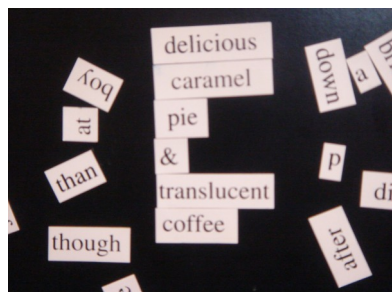
