Library Collection Analysis Results

*The average copyright date of the collection is 1998 or 12 years old.

*The ideal average copyright date is 10 years.

*We have 16,469 books in the collection, the ideal is 21,822, leaving us with a shortfall of 5,353 titles. (We have 9 books per student, ideal is 12)

*To have the ideal balance of books for each Dewey section we need to add 7,365 more titles.

The sections that need the most help are the 500's (Science), the 900's (Social Sciences) and General Fiction. The oldest sections are the 700's (Arts, Sports), Reference (Encyclopedias, Dictionaries, etc.) and the 500's (Science).

What these stats do not take into account are the number and variety of databases we subscribe to and the transition from print to electronic materials as a part of 21st Century Learning.

In order to make room for more fiction and have a better book flow, the nonfiction and reference books are being shifted to the north side of the library. There is now a "Ready Reference" section (Encyclopedias, Dictionaries, Atlases) where the Graphic Novels were. The Graphic Novels are now on the short shelves at the back of the library across from fiction. The 92's, 920's (Biographies) and Easy Books are on the three short shelves in the middle. We removed the shelves and added a new seating area between the catalog computers. We also added new Dewey Decimal System posters and soon we will have new Northglenn Library logo mats when you walk in as the old ones are in really bad shape.
